OVERVIEW

The policyholders that Michael has represented have recovered in excess of US\$2.0 billion on their insurance coverage claims.

Michael has spent much of his 30+ year legal career in the overlapping areas of insurance coverage for asbestos-related liabilities, the defense of asbestos claims, typically as national coordinating counsel, and strategic restructurings to effectively and appropriately resolve and manage asbestos-related and other toxic tort liabilities.

Michael's experience in toxic tort-related bankruptcies includes representation of debtors and third-party non-debtors, including representation of the debtors in the largest asbestos and silica-related pre-packaged Chapter 11 bankruptcy filed in the United States.

Michael's practice has included representations involving business operations or disputes in Afghanistan, Algeria, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, Egypt, France, India, Iraq, Italy Japan, Germany, Lebanon, Nigeria, Poland, Qatar, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, the UAE, the United Kingdom, and other countries around the world.
